

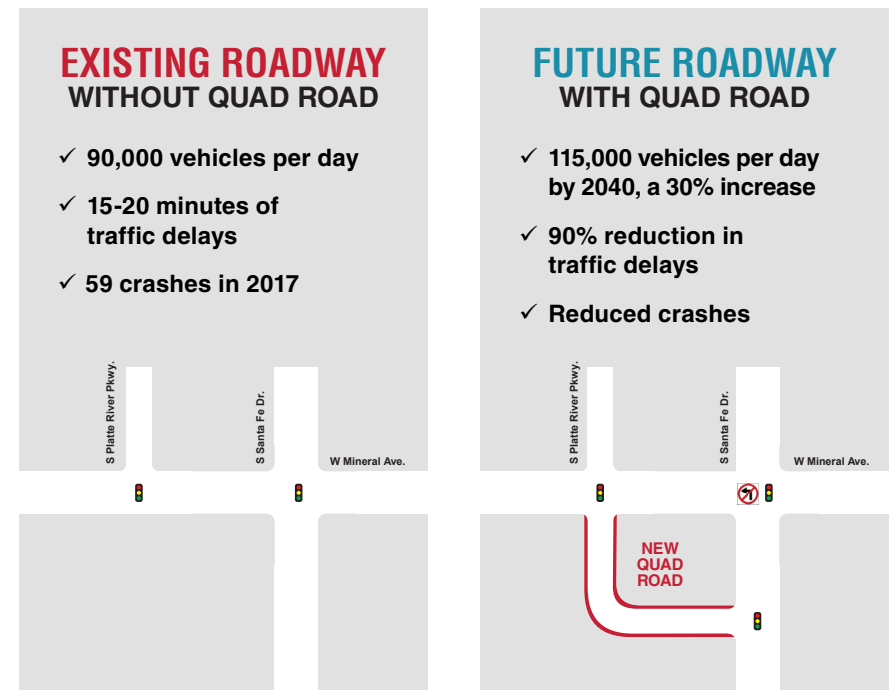
THE **INNOVATIVE SOLUTION** FOR THE SANTA FE DRIVE AND MINERAL AVENUE INTERSECTION

The City of Littleton is working to improve travel at the Santa Fe Drive and Mineral Avenue intersection by looking at ways to reduce congestion and improve safety for drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

INTRODUCING THE QUADRANT ROADWAY

FIRST OF ITS KIND IN THE DENVER METRO AREA

The quadrant roadway (quad road) is a proven and effective way to greatly reduce congestion and improve safety for relatively low costs and with minimal land impacts. The quad road concept works by shifting left turns away from the main intersection to a new connector road. Eliminating left turns at the main intersection allows more time for vehicles to move through the intersection. The design also allows additional through lanes to be added at the intersection without widening the road.
